Kannemeyer Primary School in Grassy Park celebrated former president Nelson Mandela's 93rd birthday (Monday July 18), by hosting a special programme on Saturday July 23.

The school responded to the former president's call to all South Africans to dedicate 67 minutes of their time to voluntary community work, said principal Ridwan Samodien.

"The programme was about asking parents to make a commitment to the school, because research showed that a child spends about 20% of its waking hours at school and the other 80% at home in the community.

"So what happens in the 80% is of critical and vital importance. If we can get parents to take charge of educating their children, the less chance of the evil doers like drug dealers and gangsters becoming their teachers.

"Our mission is to build good citizens and follow the lead of Madiba, who says that it is within your hands to make a difference," Mr Samodien said.

He asked for volunteers to help pupils with reading and extra mural activities, and with maintenance of the school buildings.

The school would, from Tuesday July 26, at 7pm, re-start its seven week home-school pro-

gramme, in which it helps parents of Grade R to Grade 1 pupils to help their children with their school work, he said.

Pupils showed art work, showcased poetry and watched a performance by guitarist Yaseen Kherekar and his vocalist sister Nafeesah, both ex-pupils.

There was also a photographic display highlighting the school's ongoing 50th anniversary celebrations.

Helen van Rhyn, a Grade 9 pupil at La Rochelle Girls' High in Paarl, spoke to Grade 7 pupils

about mathematics and her commitment to help them regularly with the subject.

Gillian Mercuur, who wrote a book entitled: *Improvement vs Change* also offered help to the school. Other speakers included MC and volunteer at the school Louise van Rhyn, Brain Gym SA's Mary Netto and Rita Edwards and Kannemeyer Primary teachers Sharmaine Heemro, Denise Beukes and Mercia Beziudenhout.

The proposed cemetery will be an extension of the Klip West Phase 1 cemetery. It is situated on Klip Road, Grassy Park, where the existing entrance will be used. The site is 6.11 hectares, but only 3.6 hectares will be used for graves. Roads and parking facilities will be established in the cemetery. The parking, ablution facilities and landscaping area will be a total of 0.95 hectares. There is an existing toilet block and parking on site, which means water and sewage infrastructure are in place.

The proposed cemetery is to be constructed on erven 75569 and 75570, within the Grassy Park area. The site is located at latitude and longitude coordinates 34°02'27"S, 18°29'32"E. Entrance to the property is on Klip Road.
